We begin with Judas agreeing to betray Jesus, and end with Jesus' ascension into heaven. Along the way, we will look at Jesus' deliberate journey towards winning our salvation on the cross.

In the evenings we will be continuing to look at the history of Israel. We looked at Solomon building his kingdom (1 Kings 1-3), in spring 2023, and now we are back with Solomon, considering both his greatness, and his weaknesses. Solomon rose to great heights, but even the wisest man who ever lived, was not perfect.


