## Sunday Teaching

In the mornings, we are going to look at the Old Testament Prophet Hosea, who spoke to the Northern Kingdom of Israel in the years before they were defeated and taken into exile. We see the love of a Holy God, for His chosen people who were very far from holy. We see what happens when the Holy God, and sinful people, meet.

In the evenings we will be looking at chapters 5-8 of John's gospel, which speak to us on the one hand of who the Creator God is, and on the other, of His healing work amongst humankind. We will be challenged to recognise for ourselves who the creator God is, and to accept that every single person must personally respond to Him as they live out their lives.
