Sunday Teaching

In the mornings and evenings, we are going to consider our responsibility to tune ourselves into God. We live in a world that is constantly vying for our attention, and trying to get us to focus elsewhere, to chase after the next new thing, the latest gadget, the next fashion trend. The Bible recognises the problem and is full of passages encouraging us to get ourselves back on God's frequency. We will look at 10 of them, half from the Old Testament, and half from the New Testament.

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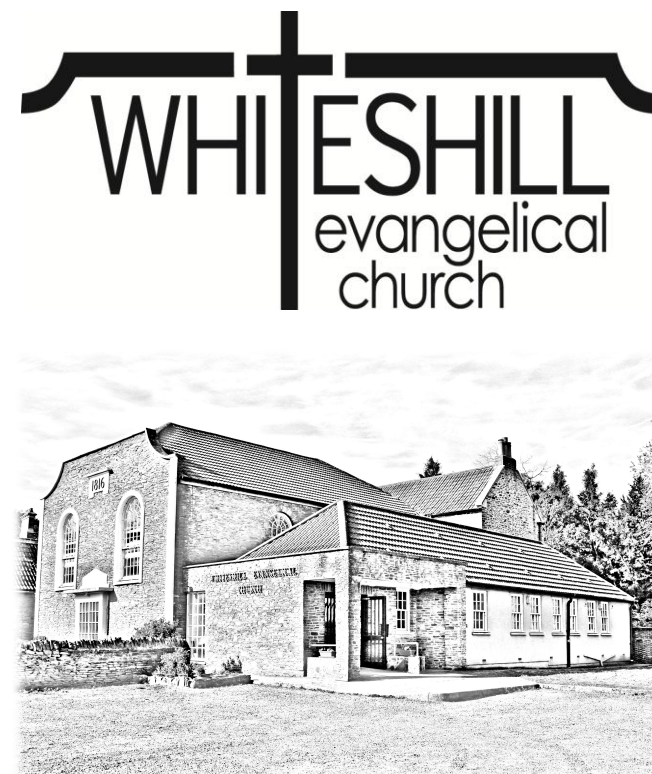
